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Teacher Led: Context notes

Focus:

• To concentrate the attention on a spatial direction or a point in the space.

• To direct and intensify attention and frame moments of dramatic action.

Challenge:

Super Challenge:

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Student Led: Change Something

In pairs, students observe one another and then one turns around.

While their partner is turned around, they change five things about themselves (physically).

Their partner then turns around and guesses the five things that they have changed.

Challenge:

Start big and then challenge your partner by changing small things (an eye or finger).

Super Challenge:

Can you use the physical skills terminology to describe the changes.

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Student Led: Honey I love you
